Welcome to MAPC's second mission conference. We pray that God would be glorified by this act of worship. Our goal for this conference is to inform you about the missionaries that the church supports and to educate you about the people they are trying to reach. We also want to share some ways that you may get involved with the Great Commission or encourage you if you are already.

We have some exciting speakers this year. Ernest Betson, pastor of the Belize City-based Unity Presbyterian and St. Andrews Presbyterian Churches will speak on Friday. In 2006, Pastor Ernest Betson and his wife Carolyn started a church plant in a poverty-stricken part of Belize City known as "The Burial Grounds." They began to notice that many of the community's young children did not attend school. On September 1, 2001, the Betsons opened a school.

Larry Trotter, MTW Mexico, will speak on Saturday. After meeting and marrying in seminary, Larry and Sandy moved to Glen Burnie, MD, where Larry served as the associate pastor. After three years, the PCA churches in the area sent them to Mexico City to work in a new church plant. Eighteen years ago, the Trotters moved to Guadalajara to start new churches. So far a strong mother church, three daughter churches, and three granddaughter missions have begun along with two schools, seminary classes, a community development center, and a foster home.

Craig Coulbourne, MTW Japan, will give us an update on his ministry on Saturday and deliver the sermon during Sunday worship. Craig and his wife Ree have been working in Japan with MTW since 1994. From 1996-2008, they worked in cooperation with a Japanese pastor to start Kaihin Makuhari Grace Church. Since 2011, they have led a new church planting work through which Shin Urayasu Grace Church was planted.

In addition to these featured speakers we will hear from many others we pray for and support. Thank you for your interest and attendance!


